

STEP 1 - PREPARING TO MOUNT THE CAMERA

- The mounting surface must withstand five times the camera weight. 1.
- 2. Do not let the cables get caught in improper places or the electric line cover can be damaged. This may cause a short or fire.
- 3. CAUTION: These servicing instructions are for use by qualified service personnel only. To reduce the risk of electric shock do not perform any servicing other than that contained in the operating instructions unless you are qualified to do so.
- 4. This product is intended to be supplied by a UL Listed Power Supply Unit marked "Class 2" or "LPS" or "PS2" and rated 12 Vdc, 0.59A (DWC-MPVA5WiAT, DWC-MVA5WiAT, DWC-MPVA5Wi28T and DWC-MVA5Wi28T), 0.53A (DWC-MPVA2WiAT, DWC-MVA2WiAT, DWC-MPVA2Wi28T and DWC-MVA2Wi28T) min.
- 5. The wired LAN hub providing power over the Ethernet (PoE) in accordance with IEEE 802-3af shall be a UL Listed device with the output evaluated as a Limited Power Source as defined in UL60950-1 or PS2 as defined in UL62368-1. 6. Unit is intended for installation in a Network Environment 0 as defined in IEC TR 62102. As such, associated Ethernet wiring shall be limited to inside the building. 7. STEP 2 - POWERING THE CAMERA

Pass the wires through and make all necessary connections.




WATERPROOF CAP INSTALLATION

The waterproof cap set comes with two rubber rings. Use the rubber ring best suited for your network cable's diameter.

Cables with ø4.5mm to ø5.5mm thickness should use the black rubber ring. Cables NOTE: over ø5.5mm in thickness should use the white rubber ring.

To ensure moisture seal, make sure the o-ring 🧿 is in place between 😋 and 🙆 NOTE: In extreme environments use of an outdoor rated sealer is recommended.




STEP 3 - INSTALLING THE CAMERA


Once all cables have been connected, use the screws included with the camera to properly 1. mount and secure the camera to the mounting surface.

Adjust the camera's pan, tilt and position to achieve the desired view. 2.

3. Once the installation is complete, tighten the pan/tilt/rotation screw until it's secure.




Mounting Template



Resetting the camera: Detach the ball module from the base by rotating it counter-clockwise. DO NOT TOUCH ANY OTHER PARTS OF THE CAMERA.


Press the reset button on the base of the camera module for five (5) seconds to initiate a camera-wide reset of all the settings, including network settings.

IMPORTANT! When replacing the camera module back into place, make sure no cables are caught or disconnected. Rotate the module clockwise until it is secured in place.



STEP 4 - DW[®] IP FINDER[™]

Use the DW IP Finder software to scan the network and detect all MEGApix® cameras, set the camera's network settings or access the camera's web client.



Network Setup

- To install the DW IP Finder, go to: <u>http://www.digital-watchdog.com</u> 1.
- 2. Enter "DW IP Finder" on the search box at the top of the page.
- 3. Go to the "Software" tab on the DW IP Finder page to download and install the installation file. 4. Open the DW IP Finder and click 'Scan Devices'. It will scan the selected network for all supported devices and list the results in the table. During the scan, the DW® logo will turn gray.
- 5. When connecting to the camera for the first time, a password must be set. a. Check the box next to the camera in the IP Finder's search results. You can select multiple cameras.
 - b. Click "Bulk Password Assign" on the left.
 - c. Enter admin/admin for the current username and Bulk Password Assignment password. Enter a new username and password to



the right.	
Passwords must have a minimum of eight (8) characters and at least four (4) combinations of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers and	
special characters. Passwords cannot contain the user ID.	
d. Click "change" to apply all changes.

- 6. Select a camera from the list by double-clicking on the camera's name or clicking on the 'Click' button. The pop-up window will show the camera's current network settings. Admin users can adjust the settings as needed. The camera's network settings are set to DHCP by default.
- 7. To access the camera's web page, click on the 'Website' button.
- 8. To save changes made to the camera's settings, enter the username and password of the camera's admin account and click 'Apply'.
 - Select 'DHCP' for the camera to automatically receive its IP address from the DHCP server. Select 'Static' to manually enter the camera's IP address, (Sub)Netmask, Gateway and DNS information.
 - The camera's IP must be set to static if connecting to Spectrum[®] IPVMS.
 - 🚹 Contact your network administrator for more information.
 - 🚹 To access the camera from an external network, port forwarding must be set in your network's router.

STEP 5 - WEB VIEWER




*The GUI display may differ by camera models.

- 1. Find the camera using the DW IP Finder.
- 2. Double-click on the camera's view in the results table.
- Press the View Camera Website
- 4. Enter the camera's username and password you setup in the DW IP Finder. If you did not setup a new username and password, a message will direct you to setup a new password for the camera to view the video.



5. When accessing the camera for the first time, install the VLC player for web files to view video from the camera.
